As a result of our discussions I can now advise that we have spoken to the owners of the three residences closest to the corner of Sandy Hook Road and Klahanie. The addresses are:

6992 Skana Crescent
5869 Klahanie

This process took longer than we anticipated because the owners of the Klahanie house do not live there. They visit some weekends and Gray was able to catch them on September 2nd.

The owners of the other two residences expressed some concerns with regard to possible truck noise and Gray gave his assurance that he would advise them when the subject is scheduled for Committee and Council so that they may make their views known publicly if they wish.

No one likes the idea of change if they think it is going to impact them personally. A lot of thought has gone into this proposal and we strongly believe it will be a plus for the great majority of those affected.

We hereby urge that you arrange for the subject to be included in the agenda for the Parks and Public Works Committee meeting scheduled for September 26th. Please confirm so that our association can have a delegation present and so that Gray can live up to his obligation to inform the home owners of the subject properties.
