RE: On-street parking violations in Sandy Hook – Your letter dated January 15, 2007

Please be advised that the following matters have been further investigated and the status of those matters is outlined below:

1. Parked white VW Passat in front of 5895 Deerhorn, License #551GDT expired in January 2005
 - Our bylaw enforcement officer attempted on numerous occasions to contact the owner of this vehicle. They were finally contacted one evening this week, and have agreed to remove the car by Tuesday, March 20, 2007. If the car is not removed from the street by the owners, the District will engage a towing company to remove this vehicle from the street
2. Parked blue Honda Civic – in front of 5899 Deerhorn - unlicensed
 - As with item number 1, our bylaw enforcement officer attempted on numerous occasions to contact the owner of this vehicle. This vehicle will be removed either by the owner, or the District of Sechelt on Tuesday, March 20, 2007
3. Fifth wheel RV in front of 6921 Mt. Richardson
 - This trailer will be moved from the road on Monday, March 19, 2007 by the owners. If this does not occur, the District will tow the vehicle.

We hope this alleviates your concerns regarding the above noted vehicles. While these parked vehicles are not posing any safety threats to vehicular or pedestrian traffic in the area, we do appreciate that they are unsightly, and are indeed violating District bylaws. The District always

attempts to contact the owners of any vehicles that need to be removed from a road, before the District takes action and tows the vehicles. As with any process, this does take some time.

Thank you for keeping us informed about issues that affect your local area residents.
